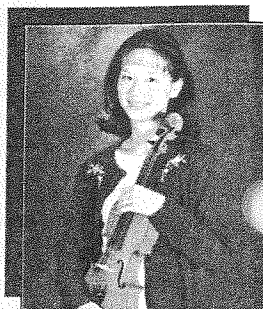

Born and raised in Arlington, Jessica, 17, is a home schooling senior. She is currently a student of Henry Rubin of Houston. She began violin lessons with Scott Buss at the age of three, six months prior to an eleven-year study with Phillip Lewis, concertmaster of the Richardson Symphony Orchestra and the Head of String Department of the School of Music at University of North Texas.

Jessica made her orchestra solo debut at the age of eleven. A member of the TMEA All-State Symphony Orchestra during her freshman and sophomore years, she has also been the concertmaster of the All-Region Jr. High and High School Orchestras. Jessica has been a member of the Greater Dallas Youth Orchestra (GDYO) program since 1990 and is currently a co-concertmaster of the GDYO. She competes in area, state and international competitions throughout the year. In 1999, Jessica won the Grand Prize in the Juanita Miller Youth State Competition and performed with the Irving Symphony. She also received the Grand Prize in the Richardson Symphony Orchestra/Lennox Competition and performed with the RSO. In addition, she was the recipient of the Grand Prize of the GDYO Competition and performed with the GDYO.

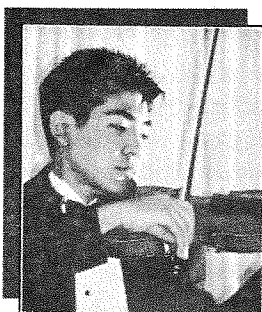

Jun Iwasaki

Jun, a student of Phillip Lewis, has been the winner of several young artist competitions such as the Richardson Symphony/Lennox Competition, Greater Dallas Youth Orchestra Concerto Competition, Plano Symphony Concerto Competition, and the Peoria Symphony Young Artist Competition. In the winter of 1997 and 1998 he was selected to perform as a member of the New York String Orchestra under the direction

of Jaime Laredo at Carnegie Hall. During 1999 he received first prize at the Hubbard Chamber Music Series Solo Competition, grand prize at the Dallas Symphonic Festival, and third prize at the Kingsville International Young Artists Competition. In 2000, Jun was selected as concertmaster of the Texas All-State Symphony Orchestra. Jun will be graduating this year from Plano Senior High School, and will continue his musical studies at the Cleveland Institute of Music. He will be studying with William Preucil, concertmaster of the Cleveland Symphony Orchestra.
